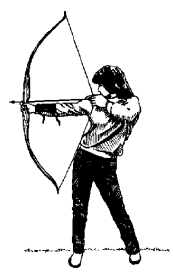

LADIES NIGHT AT THE RANGE

SUMMER PISTOL LEAGUE

The 2016 Summer Pistol League is underway and the matches will continue through August 10th at the Outdoor Pistol Range.

The league is open to the public and the cost is \$10 to register a gun or \$15 for 2 guns. Cost of registering a gun goes toward the banquet held at the end of the season.

Relays are \$1 each and we try to shoot 4 relays per evening. Matches begin at 6:45 pm and continue for 4 relays, weather permitting. There are no alibis and each shooter must provide their own firearm, ammo, stapler, and ear & eye protection. You may shoot either rimfire or centerfire, or both. 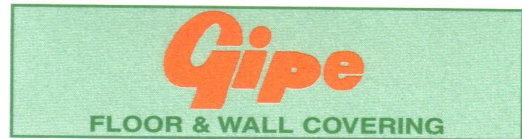
