#### POLICE PISTOL COMBAT MATCHES

HH&A's Police Pistol Combat (PPC) matches for the 2023 season have started. Matches will be held monthly on the 1st Saturdays through October on the 1st Saturdays at PPC Range #2. See our schedule below. No pre-registration is required. Just show up.

Range setup and on-site registration starts around 8:00 a.m., safety briefing at 8:45 a.m., and hammer down at 9:00 a.m. This is not a formal league, so you can shoot whenever you want and can make it. Just show up.

Five Gun Classes will be used: Stock Semi-Auto, Stock Revolver, Stock Rimfire, Stock Concealed Carry, and Open.

Cost is \$5 per relay fired. We usually run 5 relays. Cash awards for each Gun Class will be determined using the Lewis Classification System.

## CLUB GROUNDS ARCHERY HUNT

There will be an archery hunt this year just like we have done in the past. The drawing for the hunt will take place Wednesday July 12th at 7:00. For the hunt the club is divided into 4 hunting zones and you will have a zone to yourself for a week of the season.

You don't need to be present for the drawing, but if you are and your name gets picked you can select which week and hunting zone you prefer. If you are not present and your name is picked you will be assigned a week and zone. This year I will allow hunters to have a proxy attend the drawing if the hunter cannot be there. The hunter must tell me in advance who the proxy is.

The hunt is open to all current HH&A members (bring your membership card to the drawing) and is an antlered or antlerless hunt, provided you have the proper tags for WMU 5B. There will be a \$10 non-refundable fee to register for the hunt (no fee for Jr. hunters). The fee must be paid before the drawing occurs and can be paid the night of the drawing. Anyone that registers but does not pay the fee will not be included in the drawing.

#### STRIKER-FIRE CHALLENGE MATCHES

HH&A's Striker-Fire Challenge combat pistol matches will be held on selected 4th and 5th Saturdays through October. See our match schedule below. No pre-registration is required. Just show up.

Range set-up and on-site registration starts at 8:00 a.m., match rules and safety briefing at 8:45 a.m., relay 1 at 9:00 a.m.

Five continuous relays will be run at our Police Pistol Combat Range #2 from 9:00 a.m. until around noon. Cost is \$10 per relay. Fifty rounds are required per relay fired (40 for Concealed Carry).

Three Gun Classes will be used: Stock (Iron Sights only), Open (Optics allowed) and Concealed Carry (Iron Sights Only, 3.7" barrel max, 2 mags needed per stage).

Shoot as many relays as you like (pending availability of space), and shoot in any Gun Class. Cash awards for each Gun Class will be determined using the Lewis Classification System.

## ADVANCED HANDGUN PROGRAM

An NRA Personal Protection in the Home course will be offered on Saturday, September 9 (this class is full). Another class is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, October 14. Seats are limited to 6 students per class.

This 8-hour course will focus on advanced defensive shooting skills in standing, crouching and kneeling positions with and without barriers; strategies for home safety; physical and psychological responses to a violent confrontation; the use of cover vs. concealment; the current legalities of self-defense and the aftermath of a shooting. Students will shoot approximately 150-200 rounds and are required to complete a written test.

Prerequisites are the successful completion of Basic Handgun Safety, Intermediate Handgun and Defensive Handgun Skills courses. For more info or to register, contact Team Leaders Shere and Larry Gibson at <a href="mailto:personalprotection@verizon.net">personalprotection@verizon.net</a>.

## RANGE RULES

When using your club's ranges, it is your responsibility to know and understand the club's general ground rules and range regulations. They are published in the club by-laws. Copies of the by-laws are in the magazine rack just inside the front door of the clubhouse. Ground rules and range regulations are posted at each range. You are responsible for your actions on the ranges, so take the time to learn the club rules and be sure to follow them.

If you have any questions on club rules, or feel you need one-on-one training, please contact an officer of the club, or one of the board of directors, who will help you out.

Remember - safety is your responsibility. Make it your top priority.

#### INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN CLASS

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review the basics and experience more intense hands-on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. NO EXCEPTIONS. Proof of course completion is required if the Basic Handgun Safety Class was completed elsewhere.

Students are required to have a centerfire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable); semiautomatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger and revolvers must be a double action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds).

All instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$65.00, we accept cash or check only - no credit cards. Class will be held on Saturday, September 23, 8 a.m. - 1 p.m.

STUDENTS SHOULD ARRIVE BY 7:45 a.m. for registration. ADVANCE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. WALK-INS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.

## SUMMER BULLSEYE PISTOL LEAGUE

The HH&A 2023 Summer Bullseye Pistol League is underway and runs from 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. every Wednesday evening through August 23 at our Outdoor Pistol Range.

The League Registration fee is \$10 for the 1st gun and \$5 for a 2nd gun (optional).

Match fees are \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like.

Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot at 25 yards using turning target stands.

All scoring will be done by shooters downrange. Pass scorecards right, score left. Scores will be recorded and averaged for the league, and cash awards will be given out by Lewis Class at the end of the season. No banquet will be held.

Note: Two-handed shooting will be allowed, but scores will not be eligible for awards.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver may be used. Iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters/tape, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.


