2024 JUNIOR RIFLE PROGRAM

Junior Rifle starts Thursday, January 4th, 2024, and is open to all youth 11 to 18 years old. This program is open to the public. The club provides rifles, ammo and learning materials free of charge. Students will learn the basics of firearm safety and be shown different shooting positions. Class consists of classroom and range time each week. Please bring your own eye and ear protection. NRA CRSO CLASS

On February 3-4, 2024, there will be a NRA Chief Range Safety Officer Seminar for currently- certified NRA Range Safety Officers held at the Harrisburg Hunters & Anglers clubhouse from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. each day. The cost of the classes is \$140. A minimum of 4 students are required to hold the class

To become an NRA Chief Range Safety Officer, you must attend the Basic Instructor Training (BIT) class in addition to the discipline specific class (Chief Range Safety Officer Training). You may be asked to perform a pre-course assessment prior to participation in the class.

INDOOR NOVELTY SHOOTS

Held in the HH&A indoor pistol range on the following Sundays, from 1:00-3:30 p.m., using handguns AND NOW A RIFLE MATCH!

Range reserved from noon-4 p.m. to allow for range setup and tear-down.

- January 7 .22 RimFire (Handgun) Match
- February 4 .22 RimFire (Handgun) Match
- March 3 CenterFire (Handgun) Match, using .380, 9mm, .38 caliber, .45 ACP (Note: RimFire is welcome too, but CenterFire scores better!)
- April 7 .22 RIFLE MATCH any .22 RimFire Rifle any sight / scope / irons allowed

Shoot Luck Targets (e.g., cards, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, random number grid, darts, bullseyes). 5 shots per target. We usually run up to 10 relays. Shoot as many relays as you like.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with 50% cash payback to shooters. Please arrive at least 30 minutes early to register and reserve a shooting position.

Awards determined by Lewis Classification. Payouts for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.

Pistols: Red dot scopes ok. No holster required. Two-hand grip may be used.

RIFLE Match: Any .22 RimFire - any sight. Match shot standing with no support. Don't have a rifle? Come out - we'll have a spare or two to lend you!

All matches: Empty chamber indicators required when making guns safe. If you don't have one, we'll provide one free. Ear and eye protection required (must supply your own).

Come out and have some fun with us. Our matches are SAFE but FUN! Bring your shooting friends! Bring someone who has never shot "in a match" to learn how much fun the shooting sports are.

BASIC HANDGUN SAFETY COURSE

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS CLASS

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as the HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review the basics and experience more intense hands-on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Students are required to have a centerfire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable); semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger, and revolvers must be double-action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds).

All instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$65.00, we accept cash or check only no credit cards.

The INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS CLASS will be conducted on

May 11, 2024, 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. (Saturday). STUDENTS SHOULD ARRIVE BY 7:45 a.m. FOR REGISTRATION.

HH&A LEGISLATIVE & REGULATORY UPDATE

This is my first attempt to provide a written update on legislation & regulations that impact our ability to hunt, fish, trap, and our 2nd amendment rights. I have been providing updates at our monthly meetings for members' benefit. Recently, it was suggested that I share my observations and thoughts in the HH&A Newsletter. Usually I try to follow everything at the federal and state level with emphasis on state matters. This is not an all-inclusive list of items, nor do I provide any legal advice. The best place for anyone to start is with the National Rifle Association's website for their Institute for Legislative Action (NRA-ILA): https://www.nraila.org.

Two noteworthy items for this month's Newsletter come from the Pennsylvania State House. Two bills will likely advance through the House Judiciary Committee on Tuesday November 14, 2023 (This is being written before that). These bills will probably end up on the House floor to await action by the full chamber. First, House Bill 941, which would hold parents responsible for the criminal acts of a minor under their supervision who uses a firearm. The language is very vague and an attempt to shift blame for criminal actions to responsible gun owners. Second, House Bill 1629, which would require mandatory storage requirements, that, if not followed, could end up with a third-degree felony charge against a parent. These actions, while disguised as safety measures, are ways the government can pressure parents from keeping firearms.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can <u>only</u> be used if you are <u>renewing a membership</u>. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.


