



Summer Pistol League – 2026 Match Flyer



WHAT: Weekly Bullseye Pistol League. Shoot .22 rimfire and .32 to .45 caliber centerfire handguns at HH&A's Outdoor Pistol Range. No prior experience or NRA classification is required. Open to the public. New shooters are welcome.

WHEN: Wednesday evenings, April 15 through August 26, 2026. We run 4 relays per night, first shots begin at 6:30 pm sharp. Note: a free, 2-relay practice night will be held on April 8th.

COURSE OF FIRE: 30-shot National Match Course. Ten shots each of Slow Fire, Timed Fire, and Rapid Fire at 25 yards, using NRA B-16 and B-8 targets. No alibis/refires will be allowed. Shooters will score and repair targets downrange after every 10-shot target is fired.

AWARDS: League scores and averages will be kept by Gun Class, and a minimum of 50% of fees taken in will be paid back to eligible shooters as cash awards at the end of the season. Winners will be determined using the Lewis Classification System.

FEES: League registration: \$10 for 1st gun; \$5 for 2nd gun (optional). Cost per relay is \$1 (includes targets). We run 4 relays per evening. Shoot as many as you like.

EQUIPMENT: Any safe rimfire or centerfire pistol or revolver. Red dots are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers and deflector screens may be used.

AMMUNITION: Any safe factory or hand-loaded pistol ammunition. Target velocity is recommended. Round count is 30 rounds per relay fired.

SAFETY: Do not bring loaded guns to the range. A safety briefing will be given prior to start of the matches. ECIs must be used in all guns when making the line safe.

NEW FOR 2026: Junior Class and Prizes! Juniors (under the age of 21 at date of registration) shoot free for the 2026 season. Juniors that shoot at least 15 relays will be eligible for cash prizes at the end of the season, in a separate junior class. Loaner .22lr pistols (with ammo), introductory lessons on the course of fire, and mentoring will be available upon request, please contact the match director 7 days before-hand to make proper arrangements. Juniors must be capable of handling a firearm safely and follow all club gun safety rules and range commands. Shooters under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.
