WALTER WISE MEMORIAL POLICE PISTOL MATCH

September 17-18, 2022

.22 Rim Fire & Center Fire (.32 or larger) matches to be fired each day at:
Harrisburg Hunters & Anglers

Harrisburg, PA 17111

Rain or shine, 60 covered firing points, all firing at 25 yards, Lewis Classification, ten payout places in Classes A, B, and C.

FEES: Four individual 900 matches are fired, Rim Fire Sat. & Sun. a.m. and Center Fire Sat. & Sun. p.m. A competitor may enter any 1 match for \$25.00, any 2 matches for \$35.00, or all 4 matches for \$50.00. There will also be Two-Person and Four-Person Team Matches, and a special Center Fire Revolver Match (see separate flyer). Team and Revolver match fees are \$5.00 per shooter.

AWARDS: Awards in the Individual, Revolver, and Two-Person Team matches will be cash. Trophies will be awarded in the Rim Fire and Center Fire Four-Person Team matches: Open Winner, plus 3 places within Classes A and B. High Woman, Junior, Senior, Grand Senior, and Super Senior will get cash awards in match 23. Each competitor gets a commemorative brassard.

ENTRIES: COMPETITORS FIRING ALL MATCHES WILL RECEIVE PREFERENCE IN SQUADDING. Advanced registration must be done online at

<https://www.harrisburghunters.org/waltwisereg>, or by mail, prior to September 1st. Earlier is better. Payment MUST be made within 10 days. Make check or money order payable to: HH&A. Walk-on's will be accepted, if space is available.

When registering a group of competitors, you must provide a separate, completed registration form for each person. Incomplete forms will be returned. Payment MUST be made within 10 days.

The Two-Person and Four-Person Team events are paper matches; we use your Police-L course scores. **IMPORTANT** – Teams must be named and fees paid prior to any member firing. A team may enter some members on Saturday, pay all of the team fees, and have the remainder of the team fire on Sunday. A competitor may fire the Rim Fire Two-Person Team and the Center Fire Two-Person Team both days. However, bona fide Four-Person Teams only may fire on Saturday or Sunday, not both.

NO ALIBIS: The only exceptions are range alibis or when a competitor has fired on an opponent's target. In this case, the cross-firing competitor will have the shots scored as misses, and the person having the excess shots may refire or take the ten lowest shots.

DECISION OF THE MATCH OFFICIALS
WILL BE FINAL.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Rim Fire and Center Fire matches (90 shots each):

Slow Fire—20 shots—4 min/10 shots.

Police-L Course—30 shots Total.

(10—Slow, 10—Timed, 10—Rapid).

Timed Fire—20 shots—15 sec/5 shots.

Rapid Fire—20 shots—11 sec/5 shots.

All fired on Police-L targets at 25 yards.

Rim Fire matches are shot first, starting at 9:00 a.m. with the first relay; Two relays only. Two relays of Center Fire matches start after the lunch break. Competitors will fire all matches (Slow, Police-L, Timed, and Rapid) before leaving the line. Each match is completed the day fired and awards will be made that day. Each relay takes about 1 hour & 20 minutes.

PLEASE BE ON TIME.

PRACTICE: The range will be open for practice Friday, September 16th, from 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.

LOCATION: The range is located 7 miles east of Harrisburg. Traveling east from Harrisburg on Rt. 22, turn right at the Burger King and go south on Mountain Road two traffic lights to Jonestown Road. Turn left on Jonestown Road and continue to the light at N. Nyes Road. Turn right and continue to Hunters Run Rd. and turn left.

Traveling west on Rt. 22 from Allentown, or areas east of Harrisburg, turn left at the Burger King onto Mountain Road and follow above directions.

Traveling on Interstate Rt. 81, get off at Exit 72 (Paxtonia), go south on Mountain Road two traffic lights to Jonestown Road and follow above directions.

Camping is available at the Club, but only in the designated area directly behind the Bullseye Range and Picnic Grove.
