

## **PPC – Off Duty Match Course of Fire**

The Off Duty Match is shot concurrent with the Combat 600 Matches. It is restricted to the use of stock, centerfire, double-action revolvers capable of firing 5 rounds of .38 Special ammunition or larger ammunition, and stock, centerfire semi auto pistols capable of firing 5 rounds of .380 or larger ammunition. Sights must be iron sights, and <u>barrel lengths must not exceed 3.75</u>".

The course of fire for the Off Duty Match is the same as for a Combat 600 Match, except the strings of fire are 5 rounds instead of 6, all stages start from a low ready position with gun in hand, and the shooter must use the barricade for cover and support in the kneeling position at 25 yards.

When making off duty guns safe, they must be unloaded and either holstered or bagged, the same as all other guns.

Course of Fire: (50 rounds required; maximum score of 500-50x.)

<u>Stage A</u>: 10 rounds from the 3 yard line, fired in 25 seconds, standing without support, using one hand only. 5 rounds strong hand, 5 rounds weak hand.

<u>Stage B</u>: 10 rounds from the 7 yard line, fired in 30 seconds, standing without support, using two hands.

<u>Stage C</u>: 5 rounds from the 15 yard line, fired in 12 seconds, standing without support, using two hands.

- Go forward, score, repair targets, and return to the 15 yard line.

<u>Stage D</u>: 10 rounds from the 15 yard line, fired in 35 seconds, standing without support, using two hands.

<u>Stage E</u>: 15 rounds from the 25 yard line, fired in 90 seconds, all using the barricade for cover and support, and using two hands. 5 rounds kneeling (or optionally standing), 5 rounds left-hand barricade, 5 rounds right-hand barricade.

- Go forward, score, repair targets, police brass, and turn scorecards in.
