



## **Harrisburg Hunters & Anglers (HH&A)** **3-Gun Program**

### ***Match Flyer***

**WHAT:** 3-Gun (and 2-Gun) matches will be held at HH&A with multiple stages set up on the club's Tactical Range, Shotgun Patterning Range, and PPC Ranges #1 and #2.

**WHEN:** Monthly, on the following Sundays, from 8:00 am until around 2:00 pm: April 19, May 24, June 14, July 26, August 16, and September 6, 2020. Please arrive at least 30 minutes early to check-in and attend the mandatory safety briefing.

**TARGETS:** Combination of knockdown steel, paper, and frangible targets. No shoots and obstacles may be used.

**COURSE OF FIRE:** At least 4 Stages each match. Flexible order of engagement on targets. Straight Time Plus scoring.

**FEE:** Cost - \$20 cash, payable during check-in.

**REGISTRATION:** Register online at Practiscore.com.

**RULES:** See 3-Gun Rules for all Rules pertaining to the matches. Download from link on HH&A 3-Gun web page.

**EQUIPMENT:** Any safe Semi-auto Pistol, Pistol Caliber Carbine, Semi-auto Rifle, and Semi-auto/Pump Shotgun. See 3-Gun Rules for Gun Divisions allowed (Open, Tactical Scope, Tactical Limited, Heavy Metal, 2-Gun, and Pistol Caliber Carbine (PCC) and specific rules pertaining to equipment within each division. Ear and eye protection are mandatory for shooters, range personnel, and spectators.

**AMMUNITION:** Handgun/PCC: 9mm or larger. Rifle: 545x39mm or larger. Shotgun: 20 gauge or larger, shot size no larger than 7.5. See 3-Gun Rules for types of ammunition allowed in each Gun Division. Round counts will be posted on Practiscore after the stages

are planned. Will vary every month. Good rule of thumb is 150 rounds each for Handgun, Rifle/PPC, and Shotgun.

**AWARDS:** No awards, just shoot for fun.

**SAFETY:** Do not bring loaded guns to the range. All guns must be kept unloaded, and cased or bagged, until you are called to the firing line. Shooters must attend the mandatory safety briefing prior to start of the match, follow all NRA safe gun handling rules, and obey all range commands issued by the range safety officer calling the line. See 3-Gun Rules for safety rules pertaining to the matches.

**SCORING:** Done downrange after completion of course fire for each shooter.

**REPORTING:** Match Results will be reported on Practiscore.com.
