

Woods Walk - Match Procedures

- Ten stages/targets are set up for Woods Walk course.
- Start at stage number marked on Squadding/Score Sheet.
- Course of Fire sheet specifies target and distance for each shooting position. A photo of each target is included.
- Shooters will be called to the firing line one at a time.
- Start from low ready position, finger off trigger.
- When given the command, the shooter will load, and then fire one shot at a time.
- Everyone please be quiet while shooter is shooting.
- Need at least three spotters to keep track of hits & misses. Binoculars help.
- Shooter should wait until a hit or miss is declared before continuing.
- After 5 shots are completed, unload, show clear, hammer down, and holster or bag an unloaded gun.
- Enter stage score for shooter on Score Sheet.
- After all 10 targets have been shot, total the scores shown for each stage, and enter the shooter's aggregate score in the Total column.
- Turn in Score Sheets promptly at the classroom trailer when the squad is done, so we can enter the scores into the computer and figure the awards.
