## CLUB GROUNDS ARCHERY HUNT

#### SUMMER BULLSEYE PISTOL LEAGUE

The HH&A 2023 Summer Pistol League is underway and runs from 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. every Wednesday evening through August 23 at our Outdoor Pistol Range. No league banquet will be held.

The League Registration fee is \$10 for the 1st gun and \$5 for a 2nd gun (optional).

Match fees are \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like.

Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot at 25 yards using turning target stands.

All scoring will be done by shooters downrange. Pass scorecards right, score left. Scores will be recorded and averaged for the league, and cash awards will be given out by Lewis Class at the end of the season.

Note: Two-handed shooting will be allowed, but scores will not be eligible for awards.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver may be used. Iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters/tape, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.

This year we had 12 shooters. Six of them were brand new and very young.

**The Winter Championships:** The teams placed 6th and 11th out of 15 teams. The shooters placed anywhere from 21st to 76th out of 92 shooters. Great showing for a bunch of young shooters.

**NRA Sectionals**: 2 teams entered into the BB2 category (this match is based on age), they placed 1st and 4th.

**Spring Fling match** which HHA hosted: The teams placed 4th and 9th out of 14 teams. The shooters placed anywhere from 12th to 81st out of 87 shooters.

**State Championship**: The A team placed 4th out of 7 teams competing for the chance to go to the National Championship. The B team placed 7th out of 8 teams competing. The shooters ranged from 21st to 85th out of 88 shooters. Congrats to Abigail Sowers who achieved a 100 on the educational test. An overall summary is that we had a very young crew and they performed extremely well. They learned so much about competitive shooting and the educational side. We are very proud of these shooters and hope they all return next season.


