Vice-President's Pen

Can a person who uses legal medical or recreational marijuana buy a gun?

When a person tries to buy a gun, they normally must complete an ATF Form 4473, and question 11(e) asks the applicant if he or she is an "unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana or any depressant, stimulant, narcotic drug, or any other controlled substance." The question also contains a WARNING that emphasizes that marijuana possession is illegal under Federal law, so any person trying to buy a gun that is taking medicinal marijuana is unlawfully using marijuana. Therefore, the person should answer "yes" to that question, and answering yes means that the person is not permitted to buy a gun.

If the person answers "no" and is caught, the person is likely to be contacted by the police for suspicion of lying on the form. People that provide false information on the form are normally charged with a felony offense of Sale of Transfer of firearms under 18 Pa.C.S. 6111(g)(4)(ii) and a misdemeanor offense of Unsworn Falsification to Authorities under 18 Pa.C.S. 4904(a)(1).

While some state laws may allow a person to smoke marijuana recreationally or medically, Federal law still prohibits the possession of marijuana. Because Federal law makes it illegal to possess and use marijuana, Federal law also prohibits a marijuana user from possessing or trying to buy a gun.

SUMMER BULLSEYE PISTOL MATCHES

The HH&A 2022 Summer Bullseye Pistol Matches are held weekly on Wednesday evenings through August 10 at our outdoor Bullseye Pistol Range, starting at 6:30 p.m.

Match fee is \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like. Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot at 25 yards.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver may be used. Iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.

YOUTH COMPETITIVE BB GUN PROGRAM/TEAM

The BB Gun Program/Safety class will run Wednesday, October 19 through Wednesday, December 28, 2022. We meet every Wednesday and Friday between 10/19 and 11/18; Wednesdays between 11/30 and 12/21. Our program is primarily book work in October and November, then participants apply what they learned as they shoot the four competition positions. Each class builds on the previous class, so full participation is requested.

We meet in the indoor archery range from 6:30-8:30 p.m. and ask that participants and their adult (explained below) arrive by 6:15 p.m. The ages for this program are 8 through 15. For those wishing to participate on our competition team, practices will continue every Wednesday and Friday from January 4, 2023 through the end of April.

Shooters in this program have a coach on the line with them at all times. A parent (or another designated adult) fills the line coach role. Parents and coaches are required to participate in the above classes along with the shooters so proper coaching techniques can be learned. (Yes, we fully train all line coaches!)

Competitions are held February through April on various weekends around the midstate (within 2 hours of HHA). There is always a possibility of attending Nationals in Rogers, Arkansas in July 2023 (if the team qualifies at the State match in April). This would extend practices for 7 members of our team through the date of Nationals (determined in February). Fundraising is necessary for this program, which can be found under CHAMPs in the newsletter.
