Rules for the Long Shot Contest

Optional contest to be held after the Woods Walk is completed.

Centerfire and rimfire handguns may be used. Red dots are allowed.

All participants sign up and throw \$1 entry fee into the hat.

The long shot target will be whatever the Black Powder shooters have been using for the winter season. Sometimes, it is a redcoat soldier, sometimes a Buffalo, or large deer, etc.

No handling of guns until called to the firing line.

Observe all NRA Safe Gun Handling Rules during the match.

Starting at the 100 yard marker, each participant fires 1 shot offhand at the target.

A form will be provided to use for recording hits and misses.

Those who miss are out of the contest.

Those with a hit are still in the running.

Move back 5 yards and repeat. (After 120 yards, restart at 100 yards.)

Continue the process until you have a winner.

Last man standing wins all of the money in the hat.

Provide the name of the winner, the distance, and the amount of the award to the Match Director for reporting purposes.

<u>Note</u>: The Match Director reserves the right to disallow any handgun which would give the shooter a significant advantage over the other competitors.
