#### INDOOR NOVELTY SHOOTS

During the winter months of January, February, March, AND APRIL each year, we hold Novelty Shoots at our Indoor Pistol Range. We shoot a variety of fun targets at 50 feet using handguns AND RETURN-ING is a *rifle match*! Dates, times, and other match details are included in our Match Flyer linked below.

Both semi-autos and revolvers are allowed. You can use Iron sights or red dots. Holsters are not required. NO Scopes in Pistols or Revolvers.

Cost is \$2 per relay and 50% of entry fees are paid back to the shooters using the Lewis Classification System. It's a lot of fun and we usually get a very nice turnout at the matches. It's a great diversion if you are getting cabin fever.

We use Rimfire handguns in January and February, and Centerfire handguns in March.

In April – we will have a .22 RIFLE match (rimfire only). Shoot that old squirrel rifle, red dots, scopes, iron sights OK! Shoot standing – no support! If you don't have a rifle, no problem, we will have a couple of extra!

Our matches are open to the public, and beginners are welcome. Feel free to bring a shooting friend with you to join in on the fun!

#### ANNUAL HH&A BIG BUCK CONTEST

With the beginning of another hunting season the annual HH&A Big Buck Contest is under way. It is open to all HH&A members that harvest a Pennsylvania whitetail buck. Scoring goes by a modified Boone & Crockett system. There are several categories/age groups. Winners in each category will win a prize. # 2024 JUNIOR RIFLE PROGRAM

Return shooters do not need to pre-register, just show up at least 15 minutes before the relay and come to the range.

#### Wild flamingos visit Pennsylvania



...at a pond north of St. Thomas, in Franklin County - the first everreported wild flamingos in Pennsylvania. (Outdoor News, Sept. 30, 2023). Let's hope they visit HHA!



Prescribed fires by the Game Commission improve the health and resilience of forests, grasslands and shrublands. Fire improves wildlife habitat and hunting opportunities by increasing soft mast production in shrubs like blueberry, huckleberry and blackberry. Prescribed burns also reduce the severity of unplanned wildfires by removing forest debris that accumulate without regular fire. In Pennsylvania, most burns take place in March, April, May and November when grass is dormant and leaves are off, allowing sunlight and wind to dry the forest floor. #### MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can <u>only</u> be used if you are <u>renewing a membership</u>. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.


