Rifle Deer Season will soon be here. There may be increased activity on the club's rifle ranges. Please review the regulations for all rifle ranges. Keep safety in mind at all times. There should be no gun handling when anybody is forward of the firing line. This is true on all ranges.

Keep in mind that all rifle ranges are restricted to rifles only; with the exception of handguns restricted for the purpose of hunting (revolvers) may be "sighted-in" on the 100 yard range only. Rifle caliber handguns, like AR style handguns, may be used on the 25 and 50 yard ranges. Positional shooting may be done immediately in front of the shooting bench at the numbered firing points AS LONG AS NO OTHER SHOOTERS ARE PRESENT SHOOTING FROM THE BENCHES.

Times have changed. AR style rifles are more common on our rifle ranges now than hunting style rifles. Always be courteous to your fellow member and always keep safety in mind.

COMPETITIVE BB GUN

The BB Gun Program/Safety class began last month. The ages for this program is 8 to 15. Parents and coaches are required to participate in a coaches clinic 11/14 and 11/16 as part of our safety class. Each position will be taught Wednesdays from 11/28 through 12/26. Regular season practices will be held every Wednesday and Friday during January through April from 6:30 to 8:30 pm on the indoor archery range. Practices include education as well as shooting. Competitions are held February through April on various dates, within 2 hours of the club.

2019 JUNIOR RIFLE PROGRAM

Junior Rifle starts Thursday, January 3rd, 2019, and is open to all youth 11 to 18 years old. This program is open to the public. The club provides rifles, ammo and learning materials free of charge. Students will learn the basics of firearm safety and be shown different shooting positions. Class consists of classroom and range time each week. Please bring your own eye and ear protection. Course will run for a minimum of 10 weeks, every Thursday night beginning at 6:30 pm. To register, please call John Hoffer at (717)652-7659. Class size is limited, so please register early. Parent or guardian must accompany student to sign a club waiver form. A student will not be permitted to shoot until a waiver is signed.

Any shooter that is still within the age limit that has completed the classroom portion in a previous year is welcome to come out and shoot. We will have one relay for return shooters beginning around 5:45 pm. Return shooters do not need to pre-register, just show up at least 15 minutes before the relay and come to the range.

INDOOR NOVELTY SHOOTS

We will be holding our winter Novelty Shoots at the indoor pistol range on the following Sundays, from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm, using handguns:

- January 13 - .22 Rimfire

- March 10 - Centerfire, using .380, 9mm, or .38 caliber

As usual, we will be shooting paper Luck Targets (e.g., poker cards, random numbers, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, dart boards, bullseyes, etc.) at 50 feet. Revolvers and semi-autos may be used. Red dots are allowed. No holster required. Two-hand hold is ok. Usually 5 shots per target per relay, and about 8 relays.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with a 50% payback to the shooters using the Lewis Classification System. Shoot as many relays as you like. First-time shooters are WELCOME and it is open to the public. Come on out and join us for some fun, and bring a shooting friend with you.

WALT WISE PISTOL MATCH RESULTS

This year, we had 125 shooters from FL, MA, MD, NJ, NY, PA, VA, and WV compete in the 59th Annual Walter Wise Memorial Police Pistol Match which was held on September 15-16 at the outdoor Bullseye range. It was nice to see old friends and fellow shooters again! Many new friendships were made as well.

After the Colors Presentation by the PA Army National Guard, three relays of Rimfire and Centerfire matches were shot each day.

Steven Gibbons from Lewistown, PA won the match with a two-day aggregate score of 3588-252x. Hiem Trang from Gaithersburg, MD was 2nd and very close behind with 3588-225x. David Cooper from Fleetwood, PA was in 3rd with 3575-201x. Competition was fierce again this year!

In the 5-Man Team Matches, the Metropolitan Pistol League Team was the Grand Winner in both Rimfire and Centerfire. This was their 4th year in a row winning both matches.

In the 2-Man Team Matches, Kent Le and Hiem Trang were the Class A Winners again in both Rimfire and Centerfire on Saturday and Sunday.

In the Special Categories, Hiem Trang was High Civilian, Steven Gibbons was High Police and High Senior, George Reichart was High Service, Julie Latzgo was High Woman, Will Poole was High Junior, Ed Grove was High Grand Senior, and Richard Hontz was High Super Senior.

PERSONAL PROTECTION OUTSIDE THE HOME INSTRUCTOR CLASS

INDOOR PISTOL RANGE RULES REMINDER

A few members have been using B27 or other full body sized targets on the Indoor Pistol Range. Targets of this size are not allowed on the Indoor Pistol range for safety reasons. The only time they are allowed on this range is for approved and sanctioned training events such as the Handgun Safety Classes and Law Enforcement training. If you have any doubt about what targets you are allowed to use, check the by-laws or read the sign posted in the range lobby.

SUNSET SHOOTING HOURS

As we go into fall and winter, keep in mind that all shooting on all outdoor ranges must stop at sunset. Absolutely no shooting on any outdoor range after sunset, even if you think it's not completely dark. Sunset hours are listed in the Newsletter, in the Newspaper, the Weather Channel, and it is available on smartphones. There is no excuse for violating a safety rule and shooting after sunset.

IMPORTANT NOTE

As the new year approaches, please review your club's range rules. We have been seeing an uptick in rule violations; whether it being shooting after hours, or where to shoot what gun, all rules are in place for everyone's safety. Depending on the severity of the violation, you could lose your privilege to use the facilities at HH&A. The BOD has terminated memberships in the past; don't risk your membership. **KNOW the rules!!!!**

Remember — 24 hour video surveillance is in use in all areas of the club.

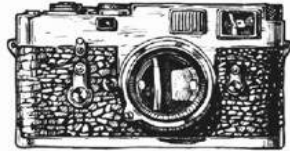
