Vice-President's Pen

On December 2, 2021, Governor Tom Wolf vetoed Senate Bill 565, which would have provided constitutional carry for Pennsylvania. Governor Wolf has a long history of restricting gun rights in Pennsylvania. Wolf previously vowed that if constitutional carry legislation reached his desk, he would do everything in his power to ensure it never became the law by utilizing his power to veto the bill.

Constitutional carry does not mean that anyone and everyone can carry. Restricted persons would not be able to legally carry under Constitutional Carry provisions.

While it didn't pass during this legislative session, constitutional carry can and should remain a priority for the Pennsylvania Legislature. And don't forget that Pennsylvania will have the opportunity to elect a new governor next year. Find out how your elected representatives voted on this now-vetoed attempt—and remember how they voted when you show up to the ballot box in future elections!

Know how candidates stand, and vote for those who will protect and preserve our Second Amendment Rights.



AR TACTICAL RIFLE COURSE

April 16, 2022 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tactical Rifle class introduces new shooters to basic rifle cleaning, maintenance, handling, and shooting skills using the AR-15 rifle. This class will introduce new shooters disassembly, maintenance, reassembly and a proper function check of the AR. Shooters will zero their weapon and shoot from three basic shooting positions. Recommend a minimum of 200 rounds of ammunition. Class will be conducted at the Police Pistol Combat Course (PPC Range/classroom).

BASIC HANDGUN SAFETY CLASSES FOR 2022

SUMMER BULLSEYE PISTOL MATCHES

The HH&A 2022 Summer Bullseye Pistol Matches start in early May and run through mid-August at our outdoor Bullseye Pistol Range, starting at 6:30 p.m.

We begin with a free practice night (2 relays) on Wednesday, April 27, and then will hold weekly matches every Wednesday evening from May 4 through August 10.

Our matches are informal, and at this point there are no plans to run them as an official league, keep scores and averages, or hold an end-of-season banquet.

Match fee is \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like. Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot at 25 yards.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver may be used. Iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS CLASS

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review basic fundamentals and experience more intense hands-on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety Class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Students are required to have a centerfire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable); semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger, and revolvers must be a double-action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds).

All of the instructors are NRA-Certified. The course costs \$65.00. We accept cash or checks only, no credit cards.

ADVANCED HANDGUN PROGRAM
