VICE PRESIDENT'S PEN

This is a summary sheet that is given to all new members at orientation. It is good information for all members to have. Please keep in mind that this is not a complete list of all safety rules. Refer to the by-laws and posted signs.

GENERAL TOPICS FOR ALL MEMBERS

Club meeting is usually the first Tuesday of the month at 7:00 pm.

All ranges and the Clubhouse are videoed as well as the entrance gate. All outdoor shooting stops at sunset. All Ranges are firearm specific. Handguns on handgun ranges, rifles on rifle ranges.

Post targets together, check targets together. Do not touch firearms while anyone is down range - EVEN IF YOU KNOW THE FIREARM IS UNLOADED.

Plinking Range ... use eye and ear protection, only shoot the swinging targets at range. No other targets may be used on the plinking range.

Brass ... pick it up and deposit in buckets, non-brass cases go in the trash. THIS IS TRUE ON ALL RANGES.

PPC Range ... for everyone's safety, do not load firearms before you reach the firing line.

No gun handling if anybody is forward of the firing line on any range. Bring your own targets and something to mount them with. Use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required when making guns safe.

Indoor range requires a proficiency qualification prior to use. Cardboard backers are not allowed on the indoor range for safety reasons. Paper targets of appropriate size only.

Handicap parking is available at PPC range, Rifle Range and Hand Trap. Ask any Board member or officer for permission.

The Club Lake is for fishing only. State Laws Apply. No swimming or boating. Membership cards and guest passes must be displayed while using club facilities.

Day Guest passes are available from any Board Member, Officers or the listed businesses.

Day Passes are \$10.00, Annual Guest Passes are \$80.00.

60TH ANNUAL WALT WISE MEMORIAL POLICE PISTOL MATCH

- To be held at the Bullseye Pistol Range on September 21-22, 2019.
- Rain or shine, 60 covered firing points with turning targets.
- Three relays of Rim Fire 900 and Center Fire 900 matches each day for 1800 daily Aggregate and two-day 3600 Aggregate.
- Rim Fire matches are shot first, starting at 8:00 am. Center Fire matches follow 3rd relay of Rim Fire each day.
- All matches shot at 25 yards, using Police-L targets.
- Course of Fire: Slow Fire, Police-L, Timed Fire, and Rapid Fire.
- Team matches are "paper matches", based on Police-L scores.
- Lewis Classification system used for determining awards in A, B, and C Classes.
- Cash awards for individual matches and 2-person Team matches.
- Team trophies for Rim Fire and Center Fire 5-person Team matches.
- Camping available on-site. No electric or water hookups.
- Motels located nearby at Exit 72 of I-81.
- Breakfast and lunch available in the club commissary both days.
- Match program and directions to club are on our web site.
- Cost is \$20 for one 900 match, \$30 for two, or \$45 for all four. Team matches are \$5 per shooter. Cost for special Walter Wise Memorial Centerfire Revolver Match is \$5 per shooter.

YOUTH COMPETITIVE BB GUN

The BB Gun Program/Safety class will begin on Wednesday, 10/16 from 6:30 to 8:30 pm, and will continue every Wednesday and Friday until the end of December. Participants will learn the basics of the four shooting positions, every Wednesday in December (12/4, 12/11, and 12/18). The location is in the indoor archery range. The ages for this program is 8 through 15. For those wishing to continue on for competition, we will meet every Wednesday and Friday from January 3rd through the end of April.

Shooters in this program have a coach on the line with them at all times. Parents (or another designated adult) fills the line coach role. Parents and coaches are required to participate in the above classes along with the shooters so proper coaching techniques can be learned. Competitions are held February through April on various weekends around the midstate (within 2 hours of HHA). There is always the possibility of attending Nationals in Rogers, Arkansas in July 2020 (if the team qualifies at the State match in April). This would extend practices for a team of 7 throughout May and June. Fundraising is necessary for this program, which can be found under CHAMPs in the newsletter.

HH&A PISTOL SHOOTERS COMPETE AT CAMP PERRY

In early July, 664 registered competitors gathered at Camp Perry, OH for the week-long 2019 National Pistol Matches. The National Matches, long considered America's "World Series of the Shooting Sports," have been a tradition at Camp Perry since 1907, attracting competitors from all across the globe to compete in a multitude of matches. Competitors include both Men & Women, from Beginners to World Class, from Juniors to Grand Seniors, and from Civilians to Military & Police.

HH&A was well represented with 11 club members shooting individually at the matches this year, and we also had two club pistol teams competing.

- Our Gold Team was composed of Rick Dare, Russell Davis (Team Captain), Bruce Davis, and Dennis Dyckman.

- The Blue Team included Jerry Dougherty, Bob Hempt, Dermid McDonald (Team Captain), Eric Poole, and George Reichart.

Both teams did well, with the Gold Team taking 1st Place and the Blue Team taking 3rd Place in the 22, Centerfire, and 45 Matches, and the Aggregate.

Individually, the HH&A shooters also did well, collecting a total of 10 top ten finishes. Four members deserve special mention for their outstanding performance:

- Russell Davis finished 4th overall in Civilian Expert Class (out of 153 shooters), earning 7 top ten finishes. Russell received his Distinguished Service Pistol Shot badge on stage at the CMP Awards Ceremony, and he also won a Bronze Medal in the Service Pistol Excellence-in-Competition (EIC) Match.

- Dermid McDonald, also Distinguished in Service Pistol, received an award on stage at the NRA Awards Ceremony. Dermid was recognized for attending the National Pistol Matches at Camp Perry for 50 consecutive years.

- Double-Distinguished Service Pistol & Revolver shooter, Tony Brong, earned 10 more points toward his 22 Rimfire Distinguished Shooter badge, and won a Silver Medal. Only 10 points to go and Tony will be distinguished in 3 different handgun shooting disciplines.
- Distinguished Service Pistol shooter, Philip Peters, also earned his first 10 points toward his Distinguished Revolver badge.

The Camp Perry experience is full of many events including competitions in traditional NRA Championship and CMP National Trophy Matches, President's 100 Match, Small Arms Firing School, M-9 Match, Distinguished Revolver Match, Harry Reeves Revolver Match, Service Pistol and 22 Rimfire EIC Matches, Glock Match, and the Mayleigh Cup. The First Shot Ceremony, Shooters' Reception, Armorer's Vans, Commercial Row, NRA Store, CMP Store, Wailing Wall, NRA and CMP Championship Awards Ceremonies, are other things to occupy your time. You also get to experience the warm camaraderie with top shooters and like-minded friends from all over, which will provide many happy memories and is nothing short of fantastic.

A few members have been using B27 or other full body sized targets on the Indoor Pistol Range. Targets of this size are not allowed on the Indoor Pistol range for safety reasons. The only time they are allowed on this range is for approved and sanctioned training events such as the Handgun Safety Classes and Law Enforcement training. If you have any doubt about what targets you are allowed to use, check the by-laws or read the sign posted in the range lobby.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND GUEST PASSES

Membership cards MUST be displayed while using any club range. NO EXCEPTIONS. Similarly, if you bring a guest, they MUST display a guest pass. Again, NO EXCEPTIONS. These rules help us all by ensuring our club is safely and responsibly enjoyed by ONLY our members and attended guests. These rules also mean that you must plan ahead to obtain a guest pass. Guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 from:

You must have your membership card with you when purchasing guest passes. Remember, if you're found with a guest using the ranges without a pass your membership can be terminated.

RANGE RULES

When using your club's ranges, it is your responsibility to know and understand the club's general ground rules and range regulations. They are published in the club by-laws. Copies of the by-laws are in the magazine rack just inside the front door of the clubhouse. Ground rules and range regulations are posted at each range. You are responsible for your actions on the ranges, so take the time to learn the club rules and be sure to follow them.

If you have any questions on club rules, or feel you need one-on-one training, please contact an officer of the club, or one of the board of directors, who will help you out.

Remember – safety is your responsibility. Make it your top priority.
