Legalization of medical and recreational marijuana is spreading across the United States and may become legal in Pa. Even if the use of marijuana becomes legal in PA, marijuana is still a Schedule 1 narcotic as far as the Federal Government is concerned. It is still illegal to possess it under Federal law. Therefore, unless the Federal law changes, if you use or possess marijuana you may be giving up your right to own or possess a firearm! Even if you have a Medical Marijuana card, the ATF says that card is proof that you cannot own a firearm. There is currently nothing in PA law that can override Federal law. Like it or not, the same is true for CBD Oils. While legalization of CBD Oil is becoming a trend, using it may very well destroy your right to own a firearm. I make no attempt to tell anyone how to run your life, but I think it important that all responsible firearms owners be informed and educated. This is how we protect and preserve our Second Amendment Rights.

COMPETITIVE BB GUN RIFLEMEN TEAM

The BB Gun Program/Safety class began Wednesday, 10/16. The safety class meets 6:30 to 8:30 pm in the indoor archery room every Wednesday and Friday until the end of November then every Wednesday in December (12/4, 12/11, and 12/18). The age range for this program is 8 through 15. For those wishing to continue on for competition, we will meet every Wednesday and Friday from January 3rd through the end of April.

Shooters in this program have a coach on the line with them at all times. Parents (or another designated adult) fill(s) the line coach role. Parents and coaches are required to participate in the above classes along with the shooters so proper coaching techniques can be learned. Competitions are held February through April on various weekends around the midstate (within 2 hours of HHA). There is always the possibility of attending Nationals in Rogers, Arkansas in July 2020 (if the team qualifies at the State match in April). This would extend practices for a team of 7 throughout May and June. Fundraising is necessary for this program, which can be found under CHAMPs in the newsletter.

ANNUAL HH&A BIG BUCK CONTEST

With the beginning of another hunting season the annual HH&A Big Buck Contest is under way. It is open to all HH&A members that harvest a Pennsylvania whitetail buck. Scoring goes by a modified Boone & Crockett system. We will measure the inside spread, the length of beams and tines, and the circumferences, but there will not be deductions for a non-symmetric set of antlers. There are categories for Archery (including crossbow), Rifle, Handgun and Black Powder in Junior (under 16), Adult, and Senior (62 and over). Winners in each category will win a prize.

ADVANCED HANDGUN PROGRAM

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS COURSE

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review basic fundamentals and experience more intense hands on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. Students are required to have a center fire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable). Semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger and revolvers must be a double action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds). All of the instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$50.00, we accept cash or check only, no credit cards.

RANGE RULES

When using your club's ranges, it is your responsibility to know and understand the club's general ground rules and range regulations. They are published in the club by-laws. Copies of the by-laws are in the magazine rack just inside the front door of the clubhouse. Ground rules and range regulations are posted at each range. You are responsible for your actions on the ranges, so take the time to learn the club rules and be sure to follow them.

If you have any questions on club rules, or feel you need one-on-one training, please contact an officer of the club, or one of the board of directors, who will help you out.

Remember – safety is your responsibility. Make it your top priority.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can **only** be used if you are **renewing a membership**. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- **If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.**
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.
- **MUST mail form and check to: HH&A, c/o Membership, P.O. Box 4129, Harrisburg, PA 17111.**

RESULTS OF THE 2019 WALT WISE MATCH

This year, we had 135 shooters from FL, MA, MD, NC, NJ, NY, PA, SC, VA, and WV compete in the 60th Annual Walter Wise Memorial Police Pistol Match which was held on September 21-22 at our outdoor Bullseye range. The weather was great, and it was nice to see old friends and fellow shooters again! Many new friendships were made as well.

After the presentation of colors by the PA Army National Guard, three relays of Rimfire and Centerfire matches were shot each day.

Khang Le was the Match Winner (this was his 7th time) with a two-day aggregate score of 3588-271x. Dan Kubar was 2nd and close behind with 3586-267x. Vernon Ferguson was 3rd with 3584-239x. Competition was fierce again this year!

In the 5-Man Team Matches, the West Caln Sportsman Club was the Grand Winner in Rimfire, and the Metropolitan Pistol League was the Grand Winner in Centerfire.

In the 2-Man Team Matches, Hiem Trang and Khang Le were the Class A Winners in Rimfire on both Saturday and Sunday. Patrick Kelly and Jerry Ford were the Class A Winners in Centerfire on Saturday, and Hiem Trang and Khang Le were the Class A Winners in Centerfire on Sunday.

In the Special Categories, Khang Le was High Civilian, George Reichart was High Service, Steven Gibbons was High Police, Julie Latzgo was High Woman, Will Poole was High Junior, Vernon Ferguson was High Senior, Ed Hoey was High Grand Senior, and Bernard Kenny was High Super Senior.

In the special Commemorative Centerfire Revolver Match, Khang Le won for the 5th year in a row with a score of 297-17x.

Five Standing Records were either broken or tied at the match this year:

- Dan Kubar tied the shared standing record for Rimfire Slowfire with a score of 200-20x.
- Khang Le tied the shared standing record for Rimfire Slowfire for the 2nd time with his 200-20x.
- Steven Gibbons set a new record for High Police Rimfire Aggregate on Sunday with a score of 900-77x.
- Steven Gibbons also set a new record for High Senior Aggregate on Sunday with his 900-77x.
- Ed Grove tied his own standing record for Grand Senior Rimfire Aggregate on Sunday with a score of 897-59x.
