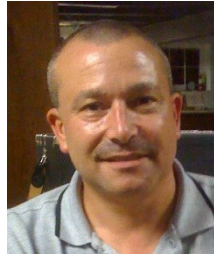

2023 JUNIOR RIFLE PROGRAM

Junior Rifle starts Thursday, January 5, 2023, and is open to all youth 11 to 18 years old. This program is open to the public.

The club provides rifles, ammo and learning materials free of charge. Students will learn the basics of firearm safety and be shown different shooting positions. Class consists of classroom and range time each week. Please bring your own eye and ear protection.

Course will run for a minimum of 10 weeks, every Thursday night beginning at 6:30 pm. To register, please call John Hoffer at 717-979-6014. Class size is limited, so please register early. Parent or guardian must accompany student to sign a club waiver form. A student will not be permitted to shoot until a waiver is signed.

Any shooter that is still within the age limit that has completed the classroom portion in a previous year is welcome to come out and shoot. We will have one relay for return shooters beginning around 5:45 pm.

Return shooters do not need to pre-register, just show up at least 15 minutes before the relay and come to the range.

WALT WISE MEMORIAL POLICE PISTOL MATCH - 2022 RECAP

This year, we had 95 shooters from CT, FL, MD, NJ, NY, PA, VA, and WV compete in the 63rd Annual Walter Wise Memorial Police Pistol Match which was held on September 17-18th at our outdoor Bullseye range. The weather was great, and it was nice to see old friends and fellow shooters again! Many new friendships were made as well. After the presentation of colors by the PA Army National Guard, two relays of Rimfire and Centerfire matches were shot each day.

As usual, competition was fierce again this year! Here's a summary of the results:

- Dan Kubar was the overall Match Winner with a two-day aggregate score of 3593-279x. John Hollings head was 2nd with 3586-237x. Julie Latzgo was 3rd with 3575-215x.
- In the 4-Man Team Matches, MPC Gold was the Grand Winner in both Rimfire (1191-74x) and Centerfire (1190-69x).
- In the 2-Man Team Matches, Ed Grove and Hiem Trang were the Class A Winners in Rimfire on Saturday (594-36), and also the Class A Winners in Centerfire on Saturday (596-33x). Brian Keyser and Julie Latzgo were the Class A Winners in Rimfire on Sunday (598-35x). Ed Grove and Hiem Trang were the Class A Winners in Centerfire on Sunday (594-38x).
- In the Special Categories, Dan Kubar was High Civilian, Bob Scarborough was High Police, Julie Latzgo was High Woman, Logan Crossett was High Junior, Dan Kubar was High Senior, Ed Grove was High Grand Senior, and Paul Saacke was High Super Senior.
- In the special Commemorative Centerfire Revolver Match, Brian Keyser won with a score of 289-9x. Mark Wengal was a close 2nd with 285-9x.
- In the Standing Records area, Julie Latzgo set a new record for High Woman with an 899-57x Rimfire Aggregate! Julie broke Ellen Woytowich's long-standing record of 899-53x.

HH&A POLICE PISTOL COMBAT WRAPS UP 2022 SEASON WITH A VISIT FROM TWO OLD FRIENDS

Our last PPC match for the season was held Saturday October 8th. We had a great turnout of 68 paid shooters. After two years of on again/off again difficulties with the pandemic, we have made quite a comeback. In fact, in 2022, we set a new shooter attendance record. We held six monthly matches with an average attendance of 77 shooters. We have a lot of new shooters, some from outside the area, even outside the state. That attendance number would be higher, but we canceled May's shoot because of inclement weather. We could not have this success without a dedicated core of volunteers with help with maintaining the range, target backers, barricades, and line painting, setting up for the shoots, and finally, statistical recordkeeping. Thanks to all the volunteers and shooters.

In 2012, one of our regular participants, Barry Nicholson, a retired corrections officer from Philadelphia, set a match record that still stands today. Barry shot a stock centerfire revolver in our combat 600 match with a perfect score of 600 with 55 out of 60 shots in the X ring! Our records indicate that Barry never received a certificate for this feat. Barry, and his longtime friend, fellow PPC shooter and corrections officer, Clarence Brown, paid us a visit to say hello to old friends at HH&A. Because of health conditions, neither Barry nor Clarence can shoot any longer. It was great to see old friends and a reminder of how special these shooting sports can be.

2023 INDOOR NOVELTY SHOOTS

We will be holding Novelty Shoots at the HH&A indoor pistol range on the following Sundays, from 1:00 - 3:30 p.m., using handguns AND NOW A RIFLE MATCH!:

- January 8 22 Rimfire Handguns
- February 5 22 Rimfire Handguns
- March 12 380/9mm/38 Special Centerfire Handguns
(Rimfire is welcome too, but Centerfire scores better!)
- April 2 22 Rimfire Rifles (New Match!)

We shoot Luck Targets (e.g., cards, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, random number grids, dartboards, bullseyes). 5 shots per target. Usually run 7-8 relays. Shoot as many as you like.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with 50% cash payback to shooters. Please arrive at least 30 minutes early to register and reserve a shooting position.

Awards determined by Lewis Classification. Payouts for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.

Pistols: Red dot scopes ok. No holster required. Two-hand grip may be used.

Rifles: Any .22 Rimfire - any sight. Match shot standing, no support.

Don't have a rifle? Come out - we'll have a spare or two to lend you!

All matches: Empty chamber indicators required when making guns safe. If you don't have one, we'll provide one free. Ear and eye protection required.

Come out and have some fun with us. Our matches are SAFE but FUN! Bring your shooting friends! Bring someone who has never shot "in a match" to learn how much fun the shooting sports are. Our Novelty shots are Open To The Public!

CLUB INSIGHTS

All range rules aim to maintain safety and preserve your club. They are posted at every range and paper copies are available in the clubhouse.

Range safety is not passive. You have to TRY to be safe. You alone are responsible for knowing and following the rules of the range you are using. If you have questions or doubts, ask a board member or leave a message on the club phone.

Also, you and every member has the right, or even duty, to care for their club by enforcing the rules. If you see something, say something. You don't have to confront another member. But gather as much information as possible (date, time, range, person's name, description, car, nature of violation, etc.), and report it to a board member or leave a message on the club phone.

- This form can **only** be used if you are **renewing a membership**. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- **If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.**
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.

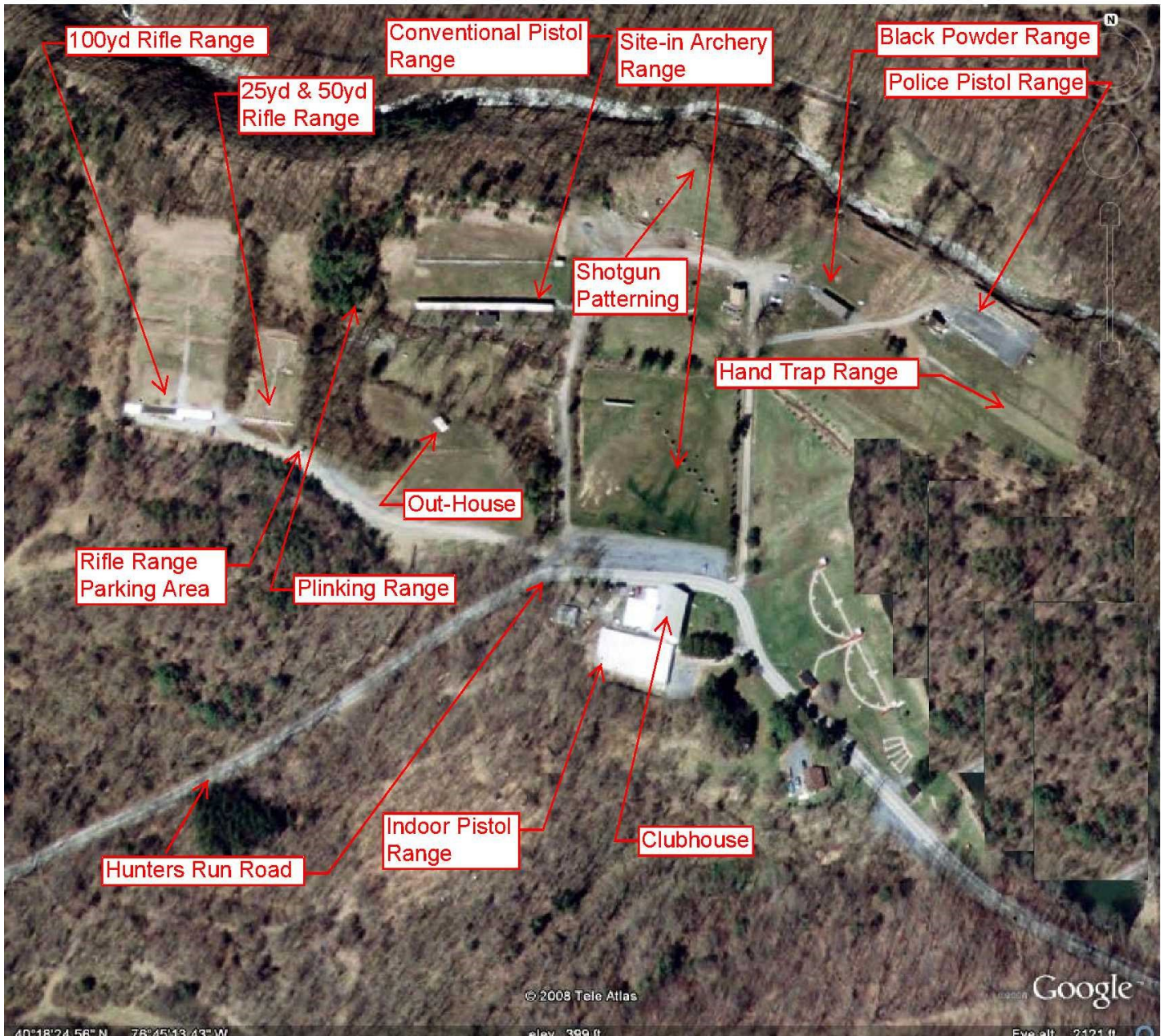
