PLEASE REMEMBER HH & A IN YOUR WILL

WOODS WALK NOVELTY SHOOT

- Saturday, April 16th, 10:00 am at the Black Powder Woods Walk Range
- Test your hunting skills on a variety of steel targets set at various distances in the woods
- Any center fire, pistol-caliber handgun may be used - up to and including .45 caliber
- No magnum or bottleneck loads allowed
- Lead or frangible bullets only - no jacketed
- No scopes/dots allowed - iron sights only
- Five shots at each of ten different targets (50 rounds total)
- Cost - \$10.00 entry fee
- 50% payback to shooters - using Lewis Classification System (Classes A, B, and C)
- Open to the public - bring a friend with you
- Be at the Black Powder Range by 9:30 am to register and attend mandatory safety briefing
- Match starts promptly at 10:00 am on the Woods Walk Range

GUN LAW SEMINARS AT HH&A

If you're a law abiding gun owner, it's important to stay informed when it comes to gun laws. U.S. Law Shield of Pennsylvania -a firearms legal defense program- will be presenting three gun law seminars at HHA in the month of April. Each seminar will cover a different topic, tailored to the requests of HHA members. The seminars include:

April 13th: Justified use of deadly force in Pennsylvania - including the Castle Doctrine and Stand Your Ground

April 20th: Laws of concealed carry, open carry and interstate travel with firearms

April 26th: Laws of search and seizure as they apply to gun owners

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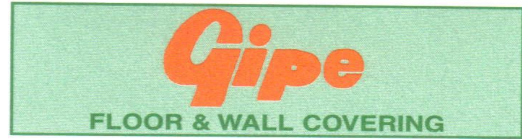
