Vice-President's Pen

Owning a firearm is a tremendous responsibility, one that should never be taken lightly. Never get complacent, keep safety in mind at all times.

A two-year-old from Texas accidentally shot his mother and sibling inside a car at a Walmart parking lot.

The 23-year-old mother of the toddler was shot in the arm and the toddler's 1-year-old sibling was shot in the leg.

Police said the toddler had taken a loaded gun kept between the seat and the center console of his parents' car outside a Walmart in Granbury.. The mother and sibling were hospitalized after the incident, but are now out of danger, police said.

The mother was slightly more seriously wounded and was taken to a hospital at by air, while the 1-year-old was transported by road.

The toddler's father was outside the vehicle when the gun was fired, Granbury police said in a statement.

INDOOR NOVELTY SHOOTS

We will be holding our 2022 winter Novelty Shoots at the Indoor Pistol Range on the following Sundays, from 1:00 p.m. to approximately 3:30 p.m., using handguns:

February 13 - .22 Rimfire Match

March 13 - Centerfire Match, using .380, 9mm, or .38 caliber (Note: Rimfire is welcome, but Centerfire scores better!)

As usual, we will be shooting paper Luck Targets (e.g., poker cards, random numbers, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, dart boards, bullseyes, etc.) at 50 feet. Revolvers and semi-autos may be used.

Red dots are allowed. No holster required. Two-hand hold is ok. Usually 5 shots per target per relay, and about 8 relays.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with a 50% payback to the shooters using the Lewis Classification System. Shoot as many relays as you like.

First-time shooters are WELCOME and our matches are open to the public. Come on out and join us for some fun, and bring a shooting friend with you.

HI POWER RIFLE CLASS

There will be a Hi Power Rifle Class on April 2, 2022 at the HHA clubhouse and 100 yard range. This High Power Rifle Orientation class introduces new shooters to basic rifle safety, basic rifle handling, and basic rifle shooting skills using the AR-15 rifle. This class is designed to introduce new shooters to safely compete in an NRA sponsored High Power Rifle Match. This class uses lecture and practical, hands-on exercises for the training sessions. The class will be taught by NRA instructors and experienced High Power Rifle Shooters. Class starts at 8:30am and ends about 4pm. Students should bring a bag lunch and dress to be in a class setting and outside on the rifle range. If you do not have an AR-15 we have several club rifles to use in the class. ADVANCED HANDGUN PROGRAM

Intermediate Handgun Grads - now is your time! The advanced classes are back starting with Defensive Handgun Skills - Level I Basics scheduled for Saturday, April 9. This is a half-day class unique to HH&A. Students will learn defensive mindset, levels of awareness, carry modes, two and three shot placement, speed reloads, clearing malfunctions and plenty of range time to practice your new skills. Prerequisites include the successful completion of the Intermediate class and a range pre-qualification. The pre-qualification date is Saturday, March 19. Class size is limited, so first come, first served. Preference will be given to students already on the waiting list. METALLIC RELOADING CLASS -- RIFLE & PISTOL CARTRIDGES

There will be an NRA Basic Metallic Reloading Class held at the Harrisburg Hunters & Anglers clubhouse on Sunday, May 29, 2022 from 9 a.m. -6 p.m. This 8-hour class teaches the basic knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to safely reload metallic cartridges. The cost for the class is \$50. It covers the instruction, the NRA Reloading textbook, NRA Safety Rules pamphlet, reloading components, and use of all reloading equipment.

Topics include introduction to reloading and reloading safety, using the reloading manual and reloading data, selecting and setting up reloading equipment, requirements for a basic reloading bench, and the actual reloading of several pistol and rifle cartridges.

An NRA Certificate of Completion will be awarded for successfully completing the course. This class is intended for beginners. Class size is limited. Copies of the by-laws are in the magazine rack just inside the front door of the clubhouse. Ground rules and range regulations are posted at each range. You are responsible for your actions on the ranges, so take the time to learn the club rules and be sure to follow them.

If you have any questions on club rules, or feel you need one-on-one training, please contact an officer of the club, or one of the board of directors, who will help you out.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can <u>only</u> be used if you are <u>renewing a membership</u>. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.
