



Striker-Fire Challenge Match – 2026 Flyer

WHAT: Semi-Auto Combat Pistol Match, using Striker-Fired Pistols (centerfire only).

WHEN: April 25, June 27, July 25, September 26, and October 31, 2026.

TIME: Range setup and registration begins at 8:00 a.m. Safety and procedural briefing at 8:45 a.m. Relay 1 at 9:00 a.m. We are usually done by noon.

WHERE: PPC Range #2 at Harrisburg Hunters' & Anglers' Association, Harrisburg, PA.

REGISTRATION: Practiscore users will be able to view match details and sign up ahead of the event, but it is not required. Walk-ons the morning of match are always welcome.

Fee: \$10 per relay. Five relays. Shoot as many as you like, pending availability of space.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to the public. Beginners and non-members are welcome. No prior competition experience required, but you must be able to handle a firearm safely.

GUN CLASSES: Stock Class (Iron Sights), Open Class (Optics), Stock Concealed Carry Class (<3.75" barrel, Iron Sights), and Open Concealed Carry (<3.75" barrel, Optics).

COURSE OF FIRE: Stock and Open Classes - 50 rounds, rapid fire. Shoot 10 rounds each in 15 seconds at 5, 7, 10, 15, and 25 yards. Stock and Open Concealed Carry Classes - 40 rounds, rapid fire. Shoot 10 rounds (2 magazines with 5 rounds each and a reload at each stage) in 15 seconds at 5, 7, 10, and 15 yards. All firing starts from a low-ready position with loaded gun in-hand.

TARGET: NRA D-1 (P) tombstone paper target.

EQUIPMENT: Any safe, striker-fired, centerfire pistol may be used. At least 2 magazines (more is better) loaded with 10 rounds each (5 rounds each for Concealed Carry) are required. Time will be allowed after each firing line to reload magazines as needed.

AMMUNITION: Any safe factory or hand-loaded ammunition may be used.

AWARDS: Cash awards for each Gun Class are determined using the Lewis Classification System. Certificates of Achievement are given to anyone who sets or ties a Striker-Fire Standing Record, and to anyone who scores a perfect score (Honorary 500 Club for Stock and Open, or Honorary 400 Club for Concealed Carry) in the match. SAFETY: Safety is paramount. We run a cold range. All guns must be brought to the range unloaded and holstered or bagged, and kept that way until you are called to the firing line and are under control of the Range Officer running the match. A mandatory safety briefing is provided to all shooters prior to the start of the matches. Ear & eye protection are required.
