It's summer and the days are longer so we are seeing increased activity on our ranges. We must all keep safety in mind and a review of the basic safety rules is a good idea.. (1) Always keep the gun (or bow) pointed in a safe direction

(2) Always keep the finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.

(3) Always keep the firearm unloaded until ready to use it.

(4) Know your target and what is beyond it.

(5) Make sure that unauthorized persons, especially children can not get access to your firearms.

(6) Make sure that your gun is in proper working order and safe to shoot.

(7) Only use the correct ammunition for your firearm.

(9) Use an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) for benched guns if you have to go forward of the firing line.

HHA is a members only club. Guests must have a guest pass and be accompanied by a club member.

Only paper targets are permitted on club ranges unless the club provides other targets.

Absolutely no shooting after official sunset on the outdoor ranges.

When there is more than one member shooting on a range, shoot together, check targets together. No handling of firearms when someone is forward of a firing line. Pick up your brass and put it in the provided buckets unless you want to take it with you. Take only your brass. Bulk brass helps support our youth programs.

In order to use the indoor handgun range, you must qualify. See elsewhere in the Newsletter for a list of contacts to qualify.

Be a safe and responsible firearms owner. Set a good example for others. Take a nonshooter to the range and help them enjoy the shooting sports. That goes a long way towards protecting and preserving our Second Amendment Rights.

### BASIC HANDGUN SAFETY CLASS

The course covers SAFETY, function, care and cleaning, sight alignment, trigger control, grip, and other information on how to shoot a handgun safely and accurately. # INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN CLASS

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review the basics and experience more intense hands-on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class **WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Proof of class completion may be required.

Students are required to have a centerfire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable); semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger and revolvers must be a double action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds).

The course is \$65.00, we accept cash or check only no credit cards.

The final class for 2023 will be held on September 23, 8 a.m. -1 p.m. (Saturday). STUDENTS SHOULD ARRIVE BY 7:45 a.m. FOR REGISTRATION.

# DAILY GUEST PASSES

Daily Guest passes are \$10.00 per day. Daily guest passes can be purchased by a member only. Members must show their current membership cards. Limit is two guests per visit.

Annual Guest Passes are available from any club officer. They are sold to current members only. Annual Guest passes are \$80.00 per year and allow a member to bring any guest as often as that member wishes.

#### SUMMER PISTOL LEAGUE

The HH&A 2023 Summer Bullseye Pistol League is winding down. Matches run from 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. every Wednesday evening through August 23rd at our Outdoor Pistol Range.

The League Registration fee is \$10 for the 1st gun and \$5 for a 2nd gun (optional).

Match fees are \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like.

Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot at 25 yards using turning target stands.

All scoring will be done by shooters downrange. Pass scorecards right, score left. Scores will be recorded and averaged for the league, and cash awards will be given out by Lewis Class at the end of the season. No banquet will be held.

Note: Two-handed shooting will be allowed, but scores will not be eligible for awards.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver may be used. Iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters/tape, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.

#### CLUB INSIGHTS

When you've been at a range, you've likely noticed those small white buckets for brass. Ever wonder what happens to the brass after you toss it in there? Well here's the answer.

On a regular basis, member Roger Rosendale collects the buckets; removes aluminum and steel cases and anything else that doesn't belong; sorts by cartridge caliber; sorts by head stamp; counts and bags lots of the same cases; marks the bags; delivers the bags to the club; and puts the remaining cases into 55-gallon barrels at the club. That's clearly a ton of work, literally and figuratively. Thanks Roger!

The bagged brass is available for sale to club members. It's listed in this newsletter monthly. As for the rest, whenever several barrels are full, maybe every couple of years, we take them to the recycling center. Because of Roger's work the brass is "clean" (meaning no other metals are in it), so we get a premium price. So how much is all this work worth? Well in June we cashed in seven barrels weighing over 3,800 pounds for \$7,250! And all that money goes to fund youth programs at your club. (Incidentally, the club added \$1,250 to that total by recycling scrap steel, aluminum, and stainless steel over the last few months.)

So now you know. Drop your brass into the buckets and it "magically" turns into money for the club's youth. Thank you.

# COMPETITIVE AIR RIFLE/SMALLBORE

The Competitive Junior Air Rifle & Smallbore Program is for youth ages 12 to 18 and runs throughout most of the year. Each season begins in September on the first Monday following Labor Day (Sept. 11th, 2023). The program includes instruction on safe gun handling, the operation of both air rifles and small-bore rifles, and the fundamentals of Olympic Style three-position shooting. Practices are held from 6:15 to 8:30 p.m. on Mondays, with additional practices when necessary to prepare for competitions. The practices are held in the indoor pistol range. We also offer the opportunity to participate in clinics, leagues, and matches. Most matches are local, while some are out-of-state.

The focus during practice is Air Rifle in the fall/winter, and Smallbore in the spring/summer. Match quality sporter and precision rifles, and ammunition are provided for use in the program. Each participant is asked to provide their own safety glasses and ear plugs.

Three Gun Classes will be used: Stock (Iron Sights only), Open (Optics allowed) and Concealed Carry (Iron Sights Only, 3.7" barrel max, 2 mags needed per stage).

Shoot as many relays as you like (pending availability of space), and shoot in any Gun Class. Cash awards for each Gun Class will be determined using the Lewis Classification System.

When at the ranges, please utilize the recycling buckets provided for spent brass, steel and aluminum cases. You can throw them all in the same recycle bucket since we recycle all three types of cases now.

We recycle the brass in two ways: (1) we sort by caliber and sell all brass suitable for reloading to club members at very good prices, and (2) we sell the remainder, along with the steel and aluminum cases, to a salvage company.

All funds made from sales and recycling are used to help fund the club's growing youth programs. Thank you for your continued support.
