CODE OF THE DAISY BB GUN RIFLEMAN

- Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- Treat every gun as if it were loaded.
- Only load or cock a gun when you are shooting.
- Check your target and beyond your target.
- Shooters and those observing a shooter should wear safety glasses and stand behind the shooter.
- Never climb or jump with a loaded gun.
- Avoid ricochet. Never shoot at a flat, hard surface or the surface of water.
- Keep the muzzle clear of obstruction.
- Guns not in use should always be on safety, unloaded and stored separately from ammunition.
- Respect other people's property.
