BASIC HANDGUN SAFETY COURSE

The course covers SAFETY, function, care and cleaning, sight alignment, trigger control, grip, and other information on how to shoot a handgun safely and accurately. Classes will meet and be held in the clubhouse at Harrisburg Hunters and Anglers'. The range session will be conducted in the indoor range. Instructors are NRA Certified. The course is \$75.00 (payable at the door via cash or check only). The course is open to the public. NO NEED TO OWN A HANDGUN. Registration starts at 7:45 a.m. Class runs from 8:00 a.m. until approximately 1:00 p.m.

Dates for the 2024 Class schedule are as follows: (These are separate classes. You attend only one class.)

U.S. LAWSHIELD SEMINAR: CONCEALED CARRY AND INTERSTATE TRAVEL

Do you carry for protection? Do you plan on traveling beyond your state's border with your firearm? If the answer to either question is "YES," then attend this seminar. You will hear first-hand from an experienced U.S. LawShield® Independent Program Attorney about the laws of concealed and open carry, gunfree zones, and considerations for legally traveling while armed in other states. Arm yourself with knowledge because "I didn't know..." is not a valid legal defense.

Seminar to be held at the club February 20 at 6:00 p.m. Advance registration is recommended.

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN CLASS

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as the HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review the basics and experience more intense hands-on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Students are required to have a centerfire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable); semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger, and revolvers must be double-action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds).

All instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$65.00, we accept cash or check only no credit cards. Class will be held May 11, 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. (Saturday). STUDENTS SHOULD ARRIVE BY 7:45 a.m. FOR REGISTRATION.

HH&A LEGISLATIVE & REGULATORY OBSERVATIONS

Two states' legislatures are preparing to enact strict laws on law-abiding citizens and trampling their civil rights in 2024. New Mexico will attempt to ban citizens from owning any rifle that will accept a magazine that holds more than 10 rounds. Meanwhile the state of Washington will try to impose a firearm purchase permit system that will allow the government to say who and who cannot exercise their constitutionally guaranteed rights.

More and more, the fight for our rights is occurring at the state capitol level. The NRA has state-affiliated organizations in all 50 states. Here in Pennsylvania, a newly minted organization is in the start-up mode. The Keystone Rifle & Pistol Association (KRPA) has just been approved as the NRA's state affiliate for the commonwealth. KRPA will be running a membership drive soon and will be taking part in the 'Friends of NRA' dinner on February 8, 2024, at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex. Please consider supporting this cause. PLEASE REMEMBER HH & A IN YOUR WILL

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can <u>only</u> be used if you are <u>renewing a membership</u>. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.



When at the ranges, please utilize the recycling buckets provided for spent brass, steel and aluminum cases. You can throw them all in the same recycle bucket since we recycle all three types of cases now.

We recycle the brass in two ways: (1) we sort by caliber and sell all brass suitable for reloading to club members at very good prices, and (2) we sell the remainder, along with the steel and aluminum cases, to a salvage company.
