BASIC HANDGUN SAFETY CLASSES

The course covers SAFETY, function, care and cleaning, sight alignment, trigger control, grip and other information on how to shoot a handgun safely and accurately. This course is offered over a period of 4 nights (see below) or we offer two weekend sessions (see below). Classes will meet and be held in the Clubhouse at Harrisburg Hunters and Anglers. The range session will be conducted in the indoor range on the final night/day of the course. All instructors are NRA certified.

YOU MUST ATTEND ALL CLASSES TO COMPLETE THE COURSE. The course is \$65.00 (payable at the first class via cash or check only). The course is open to the public. **NO NEED TO OWN A HAND-GUN.** Classes run from 5:45 pm to 9:00 pm evenings or weekend classes 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. 8:30 am to Noon on Sunday. (Range time).

WINTER NOVELTY SHOOTS

We will be holding our last winter Novelty Shoot of the season at the indoor pistol range on Sunday, March 11th from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm. This will be a centerfire match using .380, 9mm, or .38 caliber handguns only.

As usual, we will be shooting paper Luck Targets (e.g., poker cards, random numbers, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, dart boards, bullseyes, etc.) at 50 feet. Revolvers and semi-autos may be used. Red dots are allowed. No holster required. Two-hand hold is ok. Usually 5 shots per target per relay, and about 8 relays.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with a 50% payback to the shooters using the Lewis Classification System. Shoot as many relays as you like. First-time shooters are WELCOME and it is open to the public. Come on out and join us for some fun, and bring a shooting friend with you.

WOODS WALK NOVELTY SHOOT

- Saturday, April 21, 2018, 10:00 am at the Black Powder Woods Walk Range.
- Test your hunting skills on a variety of steel animal targets set in the woods at various distances.
- Any center-fire, pistol-caliber handgun may be used - up to and including 45 caliber.
- No magnum or bottleneck loads allowed, no scopes/dots allowed - iron sights only.
- Five shots at each of ten different targets - 50 rounds of ammunition required - lead or frangible bullets only.
- Cost - \$10.00 entry fee.
- 50% cash payback to shooters - using Lewis Classification System (Classes A, B, and C).
- Please meet at the Black Powder Range by 9:30 am to register and attend the safety briefing.
- Open to the public - bring a shooting friend with you.

SUMMER PISTOL LEAGUE

The 2018 Summer Pistol League starts at the outdoor range on April 25th with a practice match. The season officially begins on May 2nd and the matches will continue for 15 weeks.

Registration cost is \$10 for one gun, or \$15 for 2 guns (cost of registering guns goes toward the banquet held at the end of the season on August 22nd). Relays are \$1 each and we try to shoot 4 relays per evening. Summer League is open to the public.

AR Tactical Rifle Course

Tactical Rifle class introduces new shooters to basic rifle cleaning and maintenance, basic rifle handling, and basic rifle shooting skills using the AR-15 rifle. This class focuses on the disassembly, maintenance, reassembly and a proper function check of the AR. This Class uses lecture and practical, hands-on exercises for the training sessions. Shooters will learn how to Zero their weapon and shoot from three basic shooting positions. Recommend a minimum of 300 rounds of ammunition. Class will be conducted at the Police Pistol Combat Course (PPC Range/classroom). Classes run from 8 am until 4 pm. Class size is limited to 10 participants. - If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- **If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.**
