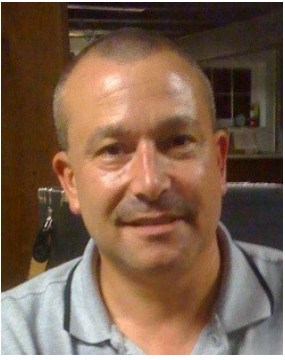

Critical Range Issues

It is becoming more apparent that there are some members who either don't care about the rules or don't know what they are. We are seeing an up tic in sloppy firearm handling, leaving spent cartridges on the ranges, using the wrong firearm on the wrong range, not using the ranges as intended. ALL of these issues are safety violations that will get your membership suspended on the spot. The rules exist for everyone's safety.



To get your membership privileges back you must explain your actions to the Board of Directors.

The board has already suspended two members for these violations in the past month. Remember there are cameras on every range and we can identify who, what and when. There are also dedicated members who give their time to check on others using the ranges. They can show up at any time and have the authority to question, ask to see membership and provide assistance to all members. Expect to see them.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND GUEST PASSES

Membership cards MUST be displayed while using any club range. NO EXCEPTIONS. Similarly, if you bring a guest, they MUST display a guest pass. Again, NO EXCEPTIONS. These rules help us all by ensuring our club is safely and responsibly enjoyed by ONLY our members and attended guests. These rules also mean that you must plan ahead to obtain a guest pass. Guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 from:

You must have your membership card with you when purchasing guest passes. Remember, if you're found with a guest using the ranges without a pass your membership can be terminated.

SUNSET SHOOTING HOURS

As we go into fall and winter, keep in mind that all shooting on all outdoor ranges must stop at sunset. Absolutely no shooting on any outdoor range after sunset, even if you think it's not completely dark. Sunset hours are listed in the Newsletter, in the Newspaper, the Weather Channel, and it is available on smartphones. There is no excuse for violating a safety rule and shooting after sunset.
