## SUMMER PPC MATCHES

Our outdoor Police Pistol Combat (PPC) matches are underway. We will be shooting continuous Combat 600 relays at the PPC Range on the following 1st Saturdays, from 9:00 am until around noon:

## 2700 CONVENTIONAL/PRECISION REGIONAL PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2109 Capital Area NRA Regional 2700 Pistol Championship will be held on Saturday and Sunday, June 22-23, starting at 9:00 am at the outdoor bullseye pistol range. NRA Distinguished Revolver, CMP Service Pistol and Rimfire "leg" matches will be held following the Regional Pistol match each day.

Club members and William Penn Pistol League members are encouraged to attend. The match program has a provision for .22 pistol across the course. And for those who only want to participate for an hour, competitors may choose to shoot only the .22 portion.

A work-party will be held on Friday, June 21 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm for range preparations. The bullseye pistol range, as well as the plinking range, will be closed during the work party and pistol match.

## INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS COURSE

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review basic fundamentals and experience more intense hands on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS.

Students are required to have a centerfire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable). Semi-automatics must be .380/9mm caliber or larger, and revolvers must be a double-action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection, and provide their own ammunition (200 rounds).

All of the instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$50.00, we accept cash or check only, no credit cards.

### ALERT — Starting with the March 2019 newsletter, the following changes have been made to the Range Events Schedule:

Membership cards **MUST** be displayed while using any club range. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Similarly, if you bring a guest, they **MUST** display a guest pass. Again, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** These rules help us all by ensuring our club is safely and responsibly enjoyed by **ONLY** our members and attended guests. These rules also mean that you must plan ahead to obtain a guest pass. Guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 from:

You must have your membership card with you when purchasing guest passes.

Remember, if you're found with a guest using the ranges without a pass your membership can be terminated.

## RANGE RULES

When using your club's ranges, it is your responsibility to know and understand the club's general ground rules and range regulations. They are published in the club by-laws. Copies of the by-laws are in the magazine rack just inside the front door of the clubhouse. Ground rules and range regulations are posted at each range. You are responsible for your actions on the ranges, so take the time to learn the club rules and be sure to follow them.

If you have any questions on club rules, or feel you need one-on-one training, please contact an officer of the club, or one of the board of directors, who will help you out.
