Critical Range Issues

It is becoming more apparent that there are some members who either don't care about the rules or don't know what they are. We are seeing an up tic in sloppy firearm handling, leaving spent cartridges on the ranges, using the wrong firearm on the wrong range, not using the

ranges as intended. ALL of these issues are safety violations that will get your membership suspended on the spot. The rules exist for everyone's safety.

To get your membership privileges back you must explain your actions to the Board of Directors.

The board has already suspended two members for these violations in the past month. Remember there are cameras on every range and we can identify who, what and when. There are also dedicated members who give their time to check on others using the ranges. They can show up at any time and have the authority to question, ask to see membership and provide assistance to all members. Expect to see them.

FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT'S PEN: FIREARMS SAFETY

Safe handling of firearms and bows is the responsibility of all members and guests. Recently it has been reported that a few members have handled firearms while somebody is down range or in front of a firing line. This is an unsafe act even if the firearm is unloaded.

IF SOMEBODY IS FORWARD OF A FIRING LINE ALL GUNS AND BOWS MUST BE MADE SAFE. NO GUN HANDLING EVEN IF THE GUN IS UNLOADED. PLACE THE GUN IN A HOLSTER OR ON A RACK OR BENCH, WITH AN EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR INSERTED, AND STEP BACK SO AS TO BE MORE THAN ARMS LENGTH FROM THE FIREARM OR BOW.

THERE CAN BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS SAFETY RULE. HANDLING A FIREARM OR BOW WHILE SOMEBODY IS IN FRONT OF A FIRING LINE IS GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL FROM THE CLUB.

Please keep in mind that our ranges are gun specific for safety reasons. Shooting rifles on a handgun range is against the rules as is shooting handguns on a rifle range. Exceptions must be approved by the Board of Directors. Read the By-Laws, Read signs.

Think Safety at all times.

Club members and William Penn Pistol League members are encouraged to attend. The match program has a provision for .22 pistol across the course. And for those who only want to participate for an hour, competitors may choose to shoot only the .22 match.

CLUB GROUNDS ARCHERY HUNT

There will be an archery hunt this year just like we have done in the past. The drawing for the hunt will take place Thursday June 28th at 7:00. The club is divided into 4 hunting zones and you will have a zone to yourself for a week of the season. You don't need to be present for the drawing, but if you are and your name gets picked you can select which week and hunting zone you prefer. If you are not present and your name is picked you will be assigned a week and zone. The hunt is open to all current HH&A members (bring your membership card to the drawing) and is an antlered or antlerless hunt, provided you have the proper tags for WMU 5B. There will be a \$10 non-refundable fee to register for the hunt. This fee does not apply to junior hunters. The fee must be paid before the drawing occurs. Anyone that registers but does not pay the fee will not be included in the drawing.

BECOMING A BETTER SHOOTER

Want to shoot better? Shooting well takes more than just knowledge of guns. It takes a solid understanding of the fundamentals of marksmanship, discipline, and lots of practice with a focus on safety. The end result will make the effort worth it!

Once you are familiar with your equipment, and its safe operation and handling, you can learn how to shoot more accurately through the application of basic shooting fundamentals (proper stance or body position, grip, sight alignment, breathing, trigger control, follow-through, etc.) and structured practice. You can learn this by taking formal training classes, and on your own with guidance/coaching from books, videos, and other experienced shooters. In time, your accuracy will improve.

An easy way to get this process started is to participate in one or more of our competitive shooting programs at HH&A. You'll meet like-minded people, gain valuable hands-on practical experience, and have an opportunity to benefit from helpful information, tips, and recommendations from accomplished experts.
