NOVELTY SHOOTS

We will be holding our winter Novelty Shoots at the indoor pistol range on the following Sundays, from 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm, using handguns:

- February 12 - .22 Rimfire only
- March 12 - .380, 9mm, or .38 caliber Centerfire only

As usual, we will be shooting paper Luck Targets (e.g., poker cards, random numbers, bowling pins, coins, pool balls, dart boards, bullseyes, etc.) at 50 feet. Revolvers and semi-autos may be used. Red dots are allowed. No holster required. Two-hand hold is ok. Usually 5 shots per target per relay, and about 8 relays.

Cost is \$2 per relay, with a 50% payback to the shooters using the Lewis Classification System. Shoot as many relays as you like.

First-time shooters are WELCOME and it is open to the public. Come on out and join us for some fun, and bring a shooting friend with you.

GUN LAW SEMINARS AT HH&A

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN CLASS

This course is a prerequisite for more advanced classes, such as HHA Defensive Handgun Skills Class. Students will review basic fundamentals and experience more intense hands on handgun training. This class will be limited in size and students must have previously completed the Basic Handgun Safety class.

Students are required to have a center fire handgun (.22LR rim fire handguns are not acceptable); semi-automatics must be a .380/9mm caliber or larger and revolvers must be a double action only .38 caliber or larger. Students must also have two magazines or speed loaders, their own eye and ear protection and provide their own ammunition (100 rounds).

All of the instructors are NRA-Certified. The course is \$35.00, we accept cash or check only, no credit cards.

INDOOR CENTERFIRE 900 BULLSEYE PISTOL MATCHES

We hold Centerfire Bullseye matches once a month on the 3rd Saturdays through March 18th at our indoor range. We run two relays each date, starting at 8:30 am and 10:15 am. DEFENSIVE HANDGUN SKILLS CLASS

The next class is scheduled for Saturday, March 25, 2017. This HHA four hour class introduces the defensive mindset, levels of awareness, accelerated shooting techniques, speed reloading, and clearing malfunctions. A centerfire handgun is required - .380 or 9mm (or higher) semi-automatic pistol with 2 magazines or .38 cal or higher, double action only revolver with 2 speed loaders (no .22 cal). Live fire includes 125 rounds. Prerequisite is Intermediate Handgun class.

PERSONAL PROTECTION IN THE HOME CLASS

The next class is scheduled for Saturday, April 29, 2017. This is an NRA nine hour course which develops mental preparation and defensive mindset, and teaches the psychological and physiological aspects of a critical incident. Students will learn cover and concealment, various shooting positions behind barriers and about the legal aftermath of a shooting. A centerfire handgun is required - .380 or 9mm (or higher) semi-automatic pistol with 2 magazines or .38 cal or higher, double action only revolver with 2 speed loaders (no .22 cal). Live fire includes 200 rounds. Prerequisite is Defensive Handgun Skills class.

INDOOR PISTOL RANGE RULES REMINDER

A few members have been using B27 or other full body sized targets on the Indoor Pistol Range. Targets of this size are not allowed on the Indoor Pistol range for safety reasons. The only time they are allowed on this range is for approved and sanctioned training events such as the Handgun Safety Classes and Law Enforcement training. If you have any doubt about what targets you are allowed to use, check the by-laws or read the sign posted in the range lobby.

* * * SPECIAL NOTICE * * *

Starting immediately, the use of 410 gauge ammo of ANY type is prohibited inside the indoor range. This ammo causes increased damage to the bullet trap.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND GUEST PASSES

Membership cards **MUST** be displayed while using any club range. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Similarly, if you bring a guest, they **MUST** display a guest pass. Again, **NO EXCEPTIONS.** These rules help us all by ensuring our club is safely and responsibly enjoyed by **ONLY** our members and attended guests. These rules also mean that you must plan ahead to obtain a guest pass. Guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 from:

- our caretaker whose phone number is posted at the clubhouse

- Ron Stine's Roffler Barber Shop, 5932 Linglestown Rd

You must have your membership card with you when purchasing guest passes. Remember, if you're found with a guest using the ranges without a pass your membership can be terminated.

Special Notice

Significant improvements are being made to the earth backstops for the 25/50-yard, 100-yard, and outdoor pistol ranges. This ongoing work may happen on any day and is not scheduled ahead of time. Therefore, it cannot be reflected in this Range Events Schedule.

Please expect that until this work is completed, you might have to change your plans upon arriving at the club. For instance, you might be able to use the 25/50-yard range but not the 100-yard. Or you might have to wait until the work is completed for the day. Or you might not be able to shoot on any of these ranges. The workers continue to only close the ranges necessary to keep them safe. Be patient and expect delays.

As always, range safety comes first. Please show the workers the safety and courtesy they deserve. Thanks.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM, DUE BEFORE JANUARY 1

- This form can **only** be used if you are **renewing a membership**. If you were a member in the past 2 years, you may use this form; otherwise, you must use a New Member Application form to obtain membership.
- If changing from an Adult to Family membership, please use a New Member Application form and follow the instructions.
- If a previous year's junior member is 16 as of January 1, they must renew as a separate member. This includes children that are part of a family membership.
- **If you do not renew your membership by December 31, your privileges to use any club facilities will be suspended (card keys will be disabled) until your renewal is received and processed. Allow at least two weeks to receive your membership card after we receive your renewal.**
- ADULT: 22-61 years, JUNIOR: up to 15 years, YOUNG ADULT: 16-21 years, SENIOR: 62 years and older (ages as of Jan. 1).
- Make checks payable to HH&A. Applicant will be responsible for all bank fees for a check returned for any reason.

This brass is recycled and all funds are used to help fund all of the club's growing youth programs. We recycle this brass in two ways. All brass not suitable for reloading is sold to a salvage company, and the good brass is sold to re-loaders in the membership at very good prices.

So, when at the ranges, please remember to support our youth programs and keep your ranges looking good by placing your spent brass in the brass buckets. Please do not place steel, aluminum, loaded cases or garbage in these buckets. Brass only!!
